**INTRODUCTION**

The Cambridge O Level, part of the Cambridge Secondary 2 Stage, is an internationally recognised qualification equivalent to the UK General Certificate of Secondary Education (GCSE).

The examination consists of two compulsory papers as follows:

Unit 1	Writing	External 50%
Unit 2	Reading	External 50%

**INTRODUCTION**

The Cambridge IGCSE English as a Second Language is recognised internationally and accepted by most universities as demonstrating proficiency in English. The qualification is assessed as follows:

UNIT	TITLE	ASSESSMENT
Unit 1	Reading and Writing	External (70%)
Unit 2	Listening	External (15%)
Unit 3	Speaking	Internal (15%)

**FUNCTIONAL SKILLS ENGLISH (AQA)**
**INTRODUCTION**

The Functional Skills English qualification at Level 1 and Level 2 (4720, 4725), gives students practical skills for the modern world and helps them get the most from life, learning and work. This course can be used in preparation for GCSE. It assesses whether students can use these skills in everyday situations. The examination consists of 3 compulsory units:

UNIT	TITLE	ASSESSMENT
Unit 1	Speaking And Listening	Internal
Unit 2	Reading	External
Unit 3	Writing	External
