MINIMUM ENTRY REQUIREMENTS INTO FULL-TIME PROGRAMME

For entry into Foundation Level:

For entry into Level 1:

This level requires the applicant to sit the College's diagnostic tests.

For entry into Level 2:

- * 5 GCSEs (including English) minimum grade E or 3 or equivalent

For entry into Level 3:

* 2 Level 3 Awards	4 GCSEs grade C or 4
* 3 Level 3 Awards	5 GCSEs grade C or 4 (preferably including English Language & Maths)
* 4 Level 3 Awards	6 GCSEs grade B or 6
